	<ol> <li>Make sure the subfloor is structurally sound, level and is free of dust and debris.</li> <li>Check for protruding nails and/or defects in the subfloor. If installing over concrete, the concrete must be dry with moisture emission rates that do not exceed 3 lbs. per 1000 square feet per 24 hours as measured by the Anhydrous Calcium Chloride Test.</li> </ol>
2	<ol> <li>Start in a corner with the tape strip side next to the wall and the overlapping film toward the open room.</li> <li>Install floorMuffler® UltraSeal (film side down) parallel to the wall in the opposite direction that you plan to install the flooring planks.</li> <li>When installing the floorMuffler® UltraSeal, leave at least 2" going up the wall.</li> </ol>
3	<ol> <li>Be sure to unfold the film, extending it 3" from the foam.</li> <li>Roll out the next roll of floorMuffler® UltraSeal in the same manner, making sure that the foam seams are butted together.</li> <li>Be sure to overlap only the moisture barrier lip and not the foam pad.</li> </ol>
4	1. <b>Remove the adhesive liner</b> and adhere the foam to the film overlap
5	1. Install the flooring per manufacturer's instructions.

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
